

**NEW SOUTH WALES VETERAN GOLFERS ASSOCIATION (INCORPORATED.)**  
**Policy Guideline No.4**

*Management Procedure to be used for the awarding of NSWVGA Trophies.*

- 1 The NSWVGA Trophy event is conducted at each "Week of Golf" in the NSWVGA tournament programme with the exception of the NSWVGA Stroke play, Match play, Sand green Stroke play, Sand green 4BBB, and Sand green Mixed 4BBB Championships.
- 2 The Trophy is a Perpetual Shield which is retained by the Golf Club conducting the event.
- 3 The event was established by the NSWVGA Executive as a gesture of good will to Country Tournament Directors, and their Committees, in recognition of the amount of work done by them in organizing their respective tournaments conducted under the auspices of the New South Wales Veteran Golfers Association.
- 4 The trophy is for competition in an eighteen Hole event on a single day selected by the Tournament Director. This day should be indicated on the tournament entry form, and also noted on a notice board adjacent to the first hit off Tee on the day of the event.
- 5 After February 9<sup>th</sup> 2012 the prizes associated with the perpetual shield will be awarded on a sliding scale which will be commensurate with the attendance figures for each event over the past four years. Whilst the value of the first and second prize will remain relatively the same, the third prize will only be awarded to the top fourteen weeks of Golf with attendance numbers at the previous events being the determining factor. The name that goes onto the Shield will be the Member who wins first place net irrespective of Grade. Lady Golfers are not eligible to win the Shield. No player can win this event if they have not booked for at least two days of the "Week of Golf".
- 6 Winners of both Members and Ladies events should receive only one other major trophy from events conducted during their "Week of Golf", apart from the NSWVGA Trophies, Ball competitions, Nearest the Pins, and any other novelty events. This conforms to NSWVGA guideline. Note: Major Trophy means first place only in your respective Grade.
- 7 NSWVGA prizes will take the form of vouchers which generally have a time limit of one year from the date of issue by the provider for redemption.
- 8 If Tournament Directors wish to allocate the NSWVGA Trophy and prizes to a 36/54 hole event they should first seek the approval of the NSWVGA Executive.
