

# New South Wales Veteran Golfers Association Inc.

## Policy No 8

### Match Play Championships.

#### General:

1. Where possible, the NSWVGA Match Play Championship should be programmed for November or December each year.
2. Players must be members of NSWVGA OR be an affiliated member of a Veterans Golf Association of another state or territory. Players may be asked to produce proof of affiliation with an appropriate body.
3. The Match Play Championship is not a Knockout Match Play event. Players will play all four days of the event even if defeated on any one day.

#### Conditions of Play:

1. Players will be divided into Divisions of sixteen and ordered according to G.A. Handicap at the beginning of the event. At the Tournament Directors discretion Divisions may be reduced to eight players if the number of entries dictate such a decision.
2. Both Men's and Women's Division 1 will play all matches as Scratch Match Play without handicap.
3. All other Divisions will play handicap Match Play. Handicaps will be applied using the full difference between the two handicaps.
4. Draw is to be on display showing starting times and likely opponents for the week. Play will be in groups of four.
5. Drawn matches in Division 1, men and women, remaining in the Championship rounds, must be decided by playing extra holes.
6. Drawn matches in remaining divisions may be decided by: (a) playing extra holes. (b) toss of a coin. (both players must agree.) OR a player may concede a match.
7. Matches must be played strictly according to the draw.
8. NSWVGA Contribution to Trophies:

Division 1 Winners. Men & Women	\$300 each
Division 1 Runners/Up. Men & Women	\$150 each
All Divisional Winners	\$80 each
All Divisional Runners/Up	\$60 each
Total based on 4 mens and 2 womens	\$1460
