POLICY No.9

Conduct of Stroke Play Championships

This Policy outlines the principles associated with the conduct of the NSWVGA Stroke Play championships.

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R. & A. Rules Ltd shall apply, together with any local rules as drawn up by the Host Clubs.
2. Entries shall be made on the official entry form provided, or a photocopy of same, or by downloading the entry form from NSWVGA website.
3. Eligible players, are Amateur male golfers, 55 years as at the first day of tournament, affiliated with the NSWVGA through their veteran group or club, or the VGA of another State, and holding a current Golf Australia handicap. Proof of affiliation will be checked using the NSWVGA database.
4. Non-Members of NSWVGA or interstate equivalent, wishing to play in the tournament can join NSWVGA by becoming a Special Playing Member of the host club by paying an additional fee set by the host club.
5. Play will be in three grades and three age divisions with handicap limits and age divisions calculated when all entries are finalised.
6. In the event of a tie for the overall stroke play championship only, a playoff will be conducted, as set down by the tournament committee. All other trophy winners will be determined by using the Golf Australia count back system.
7. Any disputes arising from a particular round must be communicated to the Tournament Committee within fifteen minutes of the completion of that round. The Committee's decision on any dispute is final.
8. Only one trophy per player permitted, except for novelty events, e.g. N.T.P'S and ball competitions, allocated in accordance with approved trophy list.
9. Trophies approved by NSWVGA will be sponsored by NSWVGA in the amount of \$2,930 and are to be allocated in the following order:
