

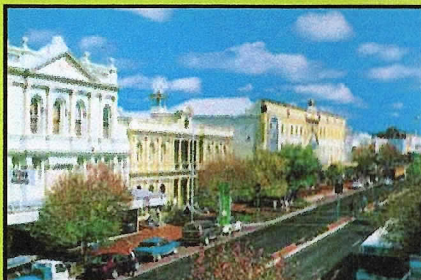

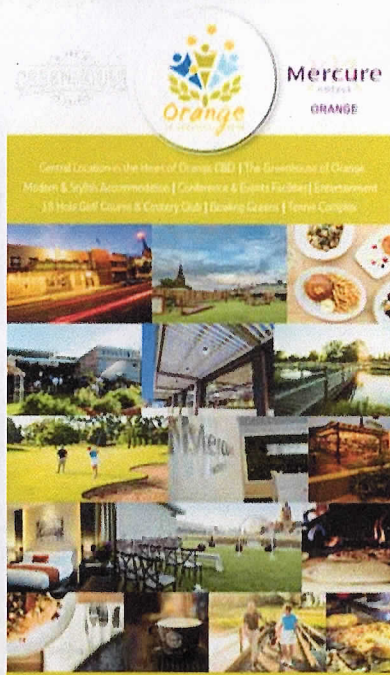

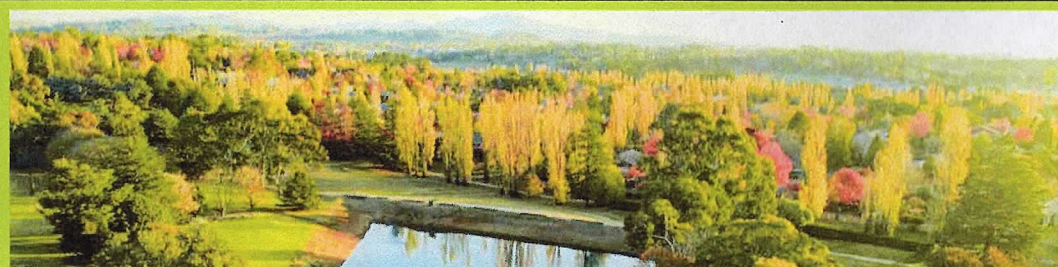

2021 THE CITY OF ORANGE VETERANS GOLF TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF PLAY.

(1) Eligibility

All entrants must be a financial and an affiliated member of a Veterans Golfers Association. Entrants must hold a current A.G.U. or W.G.A. Handicap.

(2) Acceptance

All entries will be subject to acceptance by the Organising Committee, which reserve the right to decline any entry. The appropriate entry fee must accompany the entry form.

(3) Closing Date

Entries close on the 21st January 2021 or when all positions are filled.

(4) Competition - Men

The main competition for men will be a Scratch & Nett Stableford event over 54 holes conducted in 3 Grades. The City of Orange Classic Open Mens Champion will be the entrant returning the best 54 hole Scratch Stableford score. Trophies will also be awarded in 3 grades for 54 holes Scratch & Nett Stableford and daily 18 hole Scratch & Nett Stableford events. Ball competitions & novelty events will be run in conjunction each day. Entries received will determine handicap divisions.

(5) Competition - Ladies

The main competition for ladies will be a 54 holes nett stableford event conducted in 3 grades. Entries received will determine handicap divisions. The City of Orange Classic Ladies Champion will be the entrant returning the best overall 54 hole nett stableford score. Trophies will also be awarded in the 3 grades for 54 hole nett stableford and daily 18 hole nett stableford events. Ball competitions and novelty events will be run in conjunction each day.

(6) Trophy Allocation-Men and Ladies

Tournament entrants will be entitled to win one trophy only, as allocated by the Match Committee in accordance with the tournament events priority listing, with the exception of the NSWVGA "Week of Golf" trophies, ball competitions, novelty events and the 4BBB events.

(7) Rules

The Rules of golf as per the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules of the respective golf clubs, including dress regulations, which must be observed. All tied events will be decided on a count back.

(8) Match Committee

The Match Committee will conduct the competitions and reserve the right to alter the program as may be deemed to be necessary.

(9) Handicap

G.A. Handicaps received at Registration and as applied on the 1st day of the competition will determine the grade each player will compete in for the duration of the 54 hole competitions. Scores in all 18 hole nett stableford events will be determined in accordance with the daily slope / playing handicap. Men's handicap limit will be 36. Ladies handicap limit will be 45.

(10) Starting Times.

All players must report to the starter at least 20 minutes prior to hit off times. Starters have the right to re-schedule players times when necessary.

(11) Score Cards

Scorecards must be returned to the Match Committee immediately after the completion of each round via the "Score Card Box" provided or as otherwise directed by the Match Committee.

(12) Motorised Carts

NOTE: The hire/sharing and operation of motorised carts is the sole responsibility of each entrant.

(13) Disputes and Decisions

Any disputes must be referred to the match committee as set down within Rule 34 of the R & A Rules of Golf and will be dealt with accordingly.

(14) All Golfers Play At Their Own Risk.

The tournament committee, sponsors, golf clubs and other suppliers accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss, or damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the tournament.

2021 THE CITY OF ORANGE VETERANS GOLF PROGRAM

The program for Men will consist of 54 holes of Stableford, both scratch and nett in A, B and C Grades. In conjunction there will be daily 18 hole Scratch and Nett events, ball competition and novelty events in the three grades.

The program for ladies will consist of 54 holes nett Stableford event in A, B & C grades. In conjunction there will be daily 18 hole nett stableford events, ball competition and novelty events in the three grades.

A 4BBB Medley Nett Stableford will be held at Duntryleague and Wentworth Golf Clubs on Friday with prizes available for 1st to 3rd places together with a Ball competition for each course.

The NSWVGA "Week of Golf" Trophy for Men and Ladies will be contested over 18 holes nett Stableford at Wentworth Golf Club. Trophies will be awarded to the 3 best overall men and 3 best overall ladies in this event for the day. A NSWVGA Perpetual Shield will be awarded to the best overall score of the Lady & Gentleman of the event. A NSWVGA Perpetual shield All Week of Golf trophies will be allotted as per item 6 of the Conditions of Play.

between 2.00pm and 5.00pm. All entrants will be required to show proof of current financial membership of a Veterans Golf Association and a current exact G.A. Handicap upon registering.
