Stroke Play Championships Conditions

2021 Stroke Play Championships

1. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A Rules Ltd shall apply, together with any local rules as drawn up by the host Club.
2. Entries shall be made on the official entry form provided, or a photocopy of same, or by downloading the entry form from the website –nswvga.com.au or dubbogolfclub.com.au
3. The green fees are \$75, plus \$5 if you are not a member of the NSWVGA or interstate equivalent. Payment is by direct debit with full account details available on the entry form. If unable to pay by direct debit, please make cheques or money orders out to Dubbo Veteran Golfers Association.
4. All completed entry forms and payments must reach the Tournament Director on or before 20 October 2021. With appropriate notification, refunds in full will be made on or before 25 October 2021. Any withdrawals after this date will incur a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be given after 1st November 2021.
5. Eligible players are Amateur male players, having been born on or before 1 November 1966, who are affiliated with the NSWVGA through their veteran group or club, or the VGA of another State or Territory, and holding a current Golf Australia handicap not exceeding 45 strokes. Proof of affiliation will be confirmed using the NSWVGA database.
6. Non-Members of NSWVGA or interstate equivalent, wishing to play in the tournament must pay a fee of \$5 to join.
7. Play will be in three grades with handicap limits calculated when all entries are finalised. For the 54 holes scratch championships only, the three age divisions will be determined at completion of receipt of entries.
8. For the 54 holes event, your starting GA Handicaps will be used to determine grades which will remain for the duration of the event.
9. For each of the 18-hole events, daily current handicaps as determined by Golfink will be used.
10. In the event of a tie for the overall stroke play championships only, a playoff will be conducted, as set down by the tournament committee. All other trophy winners will be determined by using the Golf Australia countback system.
11. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties can be issued for slow play.
12. Competitors will be allowed to ride in, or on, any form of automatic locomotion during play. Bookings for carts at each course will be done by the Tournament Director, based on the information provided on entry forms.
13. Any disputes arising from a particular round must be communicated to the Tournament Director within fifteen minutes of the completion of the round. The Committee's decision on any dispute is final.
