Report on the Financial Statements

I have audited the accompanying special purpose financial statements of NSW Veteran Golfers Association Incorporated (the Association), which comprises Income and Expenditure Statement for the year ended 30 September 2021, Balance Sheet as at 30 September 2021 and the Associations Committee's declaration.

Committee's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The members of the Association are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements and have determined that the accounting policies adopted are appropriate to meet the requirements of the Associations Incorporations Act 2009 and are appropriate for the needs of the Association and its Members. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error; selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies; and making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial statements based on my audit. I have conducted my audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Association Members, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial report.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

Independence

In conducting our audit, I have complied with the independence requirements of Australian professional ethical pronouncements.

Basis for Qualified Auditor's Opinion

- As is common for organisations of this type, it is not practicable for the Association to maintain an effective system of internal control over cash receipts from other sources until their initial entry in the accounting records. Accordingly, my audit relating to such income was limited to the amounts recorded in the books of account of the Association. It was not possible for me to confirm the classification of Income items as banked.
- **2.** When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current financial year.

Qualified Auditor's Opinion

In my opinion, except for the effects on the financial statements of the matters referred to in the qualification paragraph, the financial report of NSW Veteran Golfers Association Incorporated is properly drawn up so far as to give a true and fair view of the matters required by the Associations Incorporations Act 2009 to be dealt with in the financial report for the year ended 30 September 2021.
