As you may be aware, entries to our Tournament are limited to a maximum of 72 players, we will advise you as quickly as possible by email or phone if your entry has been placed on the wait list.

Please note we are struggling to get sufficient carts for our growing needs. We suggest you submit your entry as soon as possible so we can assess our cart needs early enough to initiate options if required. We also request you consider bringing your own cart if your circumstances make this feasible. Charging and storage facilities can be provided on site. We are also pleased to advise that access to accommodate caravans and motor homes to the Gloucester Golf Course property during our Veterans Week of Golf in May 2025 will be allowed.

The issues are:

The sites will only be available from Sunday night 11 May until Saturday night 17 May 2025.

- The sites are not developed, are not level and if it is wet, may be muddy.
- There is a limit to the numbers of sites available so it will be on a first come first served basis.
- Cost will be a reasonable donation to the Gloucester Golf Club.
- No provision of water, power or waste disposal is possible. All units must be fully selfcontained.
- The toilet and shower facilities in the Gloucester Golf Club are limited, only open during Club business hours and cannot be used for waste disposal. Gloucester now has an RV dump site in Billabong Park in town.
- No outdoor cooking or campfires or loud parties can be allowed.

 again, numbers are limited and will be on a first come first served basis. You will be
