

Vets Week of Golf September 2026 - Conditions of Play

The event is conducted under the guidance of the NSWVGA.

- All participants (Men & Women) must be members of NSWVGA and be 55 years of age or older on or before the first round. The NSWVGA does not permit Golf Australia Social Club Members to join The NSWVGA. All entries must be submitted with an active Golf ID number. Members A NSWVGA delegate will confirm membership or collect payment prior to commencement of the event.
- Maximum Daily Handicap: Women: 45 Men: 36
- Tee Times will be (unless weather affected):
 - Monday September 21st: 4BBB Stableford
Shot gun start from 9:00am
 - Tuesday September 22nd: Individual Stableford
Two tee start from 11:00am – 12:45pm.
 - Thursday September 24th: Individual Stableford
Two tee start from 11:00am – 12:45pm.
 - Friday September 25th: 2 person Ambrose
8:30am shot gun start

Time subject to change. Players will be advised of draws 1 week prior to the event start date.

- The 36 hole NSWVGA event will be conducted on Tuesday September 21st & Thursday September 24th. If either Tuesday September 21st or Thursday September 24th round cannot be played or completed the NSWVGA shield will be awarded to the best score over the 18 holes played. Scores will be sent to golf connect daily at the completion of the competition.
- Once entries are closed the competitions will be set for Fridays 2 person event.
- Week of Golf entrants will be entitled to win one (1) prize only, as allocated by The Howlong Golf Resort Joint Golf Committee in accordance NSWVGA guidance and Policy No. 2. The exception to this guidance and policy, being long or straightest drives, ball competitions, NTP's or any other "novelty prizes" awarded by The Howlong Golf Resort Joint Golf Committee.
- All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any modifications thereof as set out in the local rules. The current local rules can be found on the back of the scorecard or on the Mi Score App.
- Participants play at their own risk. The Howlong Golf Resort Joint Committee, sponsors, Golf Club and other suppliers accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss, damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the tournament.
- Any disputes must be referred to The Howlong Golf Resort Joint Golf Committee.
- Hire carts can be booked directly with the pro shop 02 6026 5822.
Own carts may be used please advise when entering.
- **If competitors do not wish to supply their credit card details with the entry form the pro shop team will contact the player to process payment over the phone. The credit card details are not recorded or stored when an entry is received or processed over the phone.**
- Entries close on Saturday the 5th of September at 5pm, 2026 or unless field capacity is reached. Refunds may be offered until Wednesday September 9th.

Weather Policy

- **Heat:** In accordance with The Howlong Golf Resort's heat policy a siren will sound to alert players that 38.0 degrees Celsius has been detected on the pro shop weather station. Players will be alerted to the siren and they can continue to play at their own risk. Players who wish to withdraw from the competition will have a No Score Approved (NSA) applied to their golf link record and be ineligible for daily prizes, novelty prizes and may be ineligible for the NSWVGA 36 hole event.
- **Bad Weather:** If bad weather cancels a day's play, a refund of \$20 (per day) will be given.
