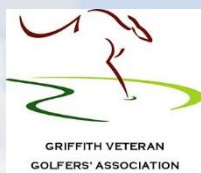

Tournament Programme

Sunday 18th October	Welcome and Registration. All players are invited to The Griffith Leagues Club from 4.30pm for registration and drinks/nibbles. Players are encouraged to stay and dine in the Club's Bistro where your Leagues Club discount voucher can be used
Monday 19th October	Individual 18 hole Stableford Event for Men and Women (Also NSW VGA Trophy)
Tuesday 20th October	Individual 18 hole Stableford Event for Men and Women (Also NSW VGA Trophy)
Wednesday 21st October	Leisure Day. We suggest you tour some of the many regional attractions
Thursday 22nd October	Individual 18 hole Stableford Event for Men and Women
Friday 23rd October	Medley 18 hole 4BBB (shotgun start at 9.00am. Numbers limited to the first 62 teams to enter) followed by a luncheon and the presentation of prizes at the Griffith Golf Club

Conditions of Play

1. The Tournament is conducted under the guidance of the NSW Veteran Golfers' Association and is open to all members of the Association who hold a Golf Australia (Golf Link[®]) handicap. Entries will be accepted from players who are not members of NSWVGA on condition that they join prior to commencement of the tournament (Monday 19th October 2026) and are no younger than 55 years of age.
2. Entrants must be prepared to produce their Golf Link[®] card and have their NSWVGA membership verified.
3. Players' handicaps will be adjusted after each tournament event. The maximum handicap for men and women is 54. Players will be graded for the tournament prior to commencement based on Golf Australia handicaps and will remain in that grade for the entire tournament.
4. The Tournament Match Committee (TMC) will control all competitions which will be run in accordance with The Rules of Golf and Local Rules posted on the board outside the Pro Shop. The TMC reserves the right to refuse any entry, to alter the conditions for any event, to set grade limits and to allocate tournament prizes. All tied events will be determined by count-back.
5. The award of trophies will follow NSWVGA guidelines whereby only one major trophy can be won by any competitor except for the NSWVGA Shields and the 4BBB event.
6. The Men's and Women's competitions on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be conducted in three or more grades (with the exception of the NSWVGA Week of Golf Shields to be contested over 36 holes on Monday and Tuesday which is open to all grades), subject to the number of entries received.
7. Entrants who have paid the full tournament fees will be provided a full refund if they have to withdraw prior to commencement of the tournament. If bad weather causes cancellation of some days of the tournament, 80% of the fees paid for the cancelled days will be refunded.
8. All players compete in the tournament at their own risk. The tournament organisers, the Griffith Golf Club, sponsors and other suppliers accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the tournament.
