CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Qualification: The competition is open to men and women who are financial playing members of the NSW Veteran Golfers Association, hold a current GA handicap and are 55yrs or older. Proof of handicap and affiliation will be required.

Handicaps: Handicaps will be recalculated daily.
Handicap limits will be Mens: 36 Womens: 45

Control: The Match Committee will control all competitions which will be run in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules adopted by the Kew Country Club Men's Veteran Golfers. Decisions by the Match Committee are binding on all players.

The event will be run under the guidance of the NSWVGA.

Players are required to check the noticeboard out the front of the Pro Shop each morning for any changes to conditions of play.

Start Times: Players are to report to the starter 20 minutes prior to their hit-off time. Late arrivals may lose their place in the field.

Protests: Any protest must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes after the completion of the round.

Ties: Any tie in any event will be decided by countback.

Grades: Grade limits will be set after the close of entries.
Grades for the week will be as equal as possible.

Prizes: Winners of both men and ladies' events may receive only one major trophy during the week, with the exception of the NSWVGA Shield and nearest the pin balls. Players must have completed two (2) full rounds to be eligible for the NSWVGA Shield.

Wet Weather Policy: Play will be held unless it is too dangerous to do so or the course is closed. A full refund will be provided where play has not commenced and thereafter will be considered by the Match Committee.

Refund: Due to the current situation and uncertainty with petrol/diesel supply, and should the situation deteriorate further preventing entrants from attending, a full refund will be made available.

Carts: Must be ordered on the entry forms and paid for at the Pro Shop each day. Players who wish to share carts within their group are required to nominate the person they wish to share with on the Entry Form.

Private carts will be permitted, and there will be no charge.
